POLICY DOCUMENT: GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Credits required for graduation	
IGCSE level credits	16
A-level credits	7
Extra-curricular credits	2
Total	25

In order to graduate, the student must achieve a minimum of 16 IGCSE level (or equivalent) credits, 7 A-level (or equivalent) credits and two extra-curricular credits offered through the *Electives* programme in Year 10-11.

IGCSE English Language, Mathematics, Coordinated Sciences, Geography/History/Sociology, Art/Music, PE and Global Perspectives are required courses.

Learners must achieve at least one credit from each of Groups 1, 2 and 3. The remaining credits can come from any of the groups. A maximum of two credits can count from Group 4.
